NEW SIMULATION LABS OPEN AT SACN

ROCKFORD, Ill—OSF Saint Anthony College of Nursing faculty, staff and administration hosted an official ribbon cutting for two new simulation labs that were constructed at the Guilford Square campus located at 698 Featherstone Road.

The new labs include a community health lab and a neonatal/OB lab. Nursing students now have the opportunity to experience what it's like to be an OB nurse during childbirth. In addition, the community lab is constructed like a living room to simulate home health visits.

"The community simulation labs are unique to not only this region but the entire country," said Beth Carson, Dean of the Undergraduate program, "this particular lab is not a high-fidelity lab like our others at the college as the idea is to mimic home health visits including patients with a mental health issues."

The new simulation labs were funded in part with proceeds from the 2015 OSF Foundation Annual Pink Ball.
